



## Barcelona Walking Tours

Daily 2 hour scheduled walking tours of Barcelona with Catalonia Tours and the Turisme de Barcelona. Once you have selected the tour of your choice, booked online and received your Tour Voucher you can then make your way to Turisme de Barcelona Information Office at Plaça de Catalunya, hand the voucher in 10 mins before the tour begins and join the Barcelona Walking Tour you have chosen. An English speaking professional guide will accompany you on your discovery of the city. The tours are guaranteed but places are limited so please book early to avoid disappointment.

The tours will not run on the following days 1/1, 6/1, 25/12 & 26/12

**Gothic Quarter Tour.** You can discover the city's history as you stroll through the squares and streets of the Gothic Quarter, one of the best preserved medieval districts in the Barcelona.

**Prices:** Adults 9.50 euros and children (aged 4 to 12 years) 4 euros.  
**Tour Times:** Monday to Sunday 10.00am

**Modernism Tour.** The Modernism tour takes you through the Quadrat d'Or (Golden Square) in the Eixample district where you can admire the Catalan art-nouveau buildings by architects such as Gaudí, Domènech & Montaner and Puig & Cadafalch.

**Prices:** Adults 10.50 euros and children (aged 4 to 12 years) 4 euros.  
**Tour Times:** Friday and Saturdays at 4.00pm (From June to September at 6.00pm).

**Gourmet Tour.** Enjoy a flavour-filled journey and discover the history of Barcelona's cuisine on the Gourmet walking tour of the city's old town with tastings included.

**Prices:** Adults 14 euros and children (aged 4 to 12 years) 8 euros. Including two tastings.  
**Tour Times:** Fridays and Saturdays except holidays at 11.00am.

**Picasso Tour.** Follow in the footsteps of Picasso and the 19th and 20th century Bohemian movement. Includes a visit to the Picasso Museum.

**Prices:** Adults 12 euros and children (aged 4 to 12 years) 6 euros. Including admission to the Picasso Museum.  
**Tour Times:** Tuesday to Sunday at 10.30am.
